        For example:
        Old + -er = older
        Tall + -er = taller

    If the adjective ends with

<u>consonant</u>-vowel-<u>consonant</u>, double the last letter + -er

For example:

<u>big</u> + -er = bigger

<u>fat</u> + -er = fatter

<u>thin</u> + -er = thinner
