BE 동사 (~이다, 존재하다)

Be -am / is/ are

I am

You are

He/She/It is

They are

Be 동사 (현재->과거)

- •Am -> Was
- •ls -> was
- •Are -> were

Be 동사의 과거시제

- I am happy today.
- -> I was happy yesterday.

She is happy today.

-> She was happy yesterday.

They are happy today.

-> They were happy yesterday.

- You are my friend.
- •-> You were my friend.
- You are my friends.
- •-> You were my friends.

Be 동사의 과거시제(was/were)

- 부정문 (negative)
- I am not (I'm not)happy today.
- •-> I wasn't happy yesterday.
- She is not (isn't) happy today.
- -> She <u>wasn't</u> happy <u>yesterday</u>.
- They are not (aren't) happy today.
- -> They weren't happy yesterday.

나는 화나지 않았었어.

- •I was not angry.
- •I wasn't angry.

그들은 체육관(the gym)에 없 었어.

- •They were not in the gym.
- •They weren't in the gym.

그녀는 예쁘지 않았어.

- She was not pretty.
- •She wasn't pretty.

(의문문) 그는 화 났었니?

- •He was angry.
- •Was he angry?.

그들은 체육관에 있었니?

- •They were in the gym.
- •Were they in the gym?

It was delicious.
